Following are the communication items for this week:

December 13th City Council Meeting

In Monday's City Council meeting, Council voted to approve two races through the city in 2022, the Angels' Place Race on May 14th and the Waterford Bank Half-Marathon on November 12th. A motion to utilize a recently obtained \$3,000 grant from the Clarkston Area Optimists to construct and install a small footbridge over the Depot Park raingarden was approved, pending HDC approval. A resolution to spend \$5,069 to repair the underbody scraper on the City's large dump truck was discussed and approved. A proposal to have the Planning Commission research the possibility of a new rental housing inspection ordinance was approved. Kevin Knapp and Robert Sowles were nominated and confirmed to replace two Planning Commission members who are retiring. Lastly, the December 27th City Council meeting was cancelled. The next City Council meeting is scheduled for Monday, January 10th.
